This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered between THE DIAMOND HARBOUR WOMEN'S UNIVERSITY (DHWU) and INNOVATIVE CENTRE FOR COMPARATIVE INDIAN LITERATURE & LOKAABHARAN SCIENTIFIC RESEARCH (ICCILLSR), KOLKATA with effect from 1.8. 2.2.3.. with an aim to achieve excellence in teaching, research and other academic activities through interinstitutional collaboration. The areas of cooperation may include, subject to mutual consent, any desirable and feasible activities keeping in view the goals and objectives of each institution. Such interaction may include cooperation in a variety of joint academic and educational activities such as:

- Exchange of faculties and students based on reciprocity:
- · Holding conferences/seminars and workshops jointly;
- · Taking special lectures/classes;
- Collaboration in the field of supervising Diploma Course, Certificate Course or any other Courses which may be introduced from time to time;
- To submit applications for joint research projects and seek grants;
- Offering value added and skill development courses:
- · Use of each other's infrastructure facilities, as and when possible; and
- Any other events / programmes that aim to promote interdisciplinary studies and research.

The parties anticipate that a number of these initiatives will occur during the period of this MoU. However, neither party is obligated to agree to any minimum number of activities, nor is this MoU intended to preclude either party from entering into similar agreements with other institutions.

This MoU shall be identified as the parent document of any programme agreement executed between the parties. Further agreements concerning any programme shall provide details concerning the specific commitments made by each party and shall not become effective until they have been reduced to writing, executed by the duly authorized representatives of both the parties.

For agreed upon activities, both institutions will make available their facilities and staffs. This MoU will take effect on 1.8.08.23...and will be valid for five (5) years from the date noted in the first line of this document unless terminated by one of the parties. Either party may withdraw from this MoU provided that a written notification of the withdrawal is given to the other party at least six months prior to the desired withdrawal date. This MoU may be renewed for another period of five (5) years upon mutual written consent of the parties before the expiration date. Each institution will have copies of this agreement.

This MoU serves only as a record of the parties' intentions and understandings and does not constitute or create, and is not intended to constitute or create obligations under domestic or international law and will not give rise to any legal process in any court of law and will not be deemed to constitute or create any legally binding or enforceable obligations, express or implied and this MoU is not legally enforceable in any court of law in India and abroad. Specific programmes and events will be discussed separately and formalized under the broad terms of the MoU agreed between both the parties.

In the first phase it is decided that Diploma in Journalism and Mass Communication, Media will be commenced with effect from mutual consent. The course will be held in the premises of ICCILLSR. Total responsibility lies with the ICCILLSR regarding conducting the course, holding Examinations, Publication of results, distribution of Mark sheets and Certificates etc.

ICCILLSR will accommodate 2 representatives of DHWU in each of their Managing Committee / Governing Body / Executive Council and Syllabus Committee.

DHWU has a supervisory power and can offer suggestions, advices for the improvement of academic and administrative excellence which must be complied by the ICCILLSR.

Role of ICCILLSR:

i) Taking admission

ii) Conducting the course

ii) Taking classes / Practical's / Project / Dissertation / Internship

iv) Holding Examination v) Publication of result

vi) Giving Mark sheets and Certificates to Students in time

vii) Other academic and administrative activities to run the course

smoothly

Role of DHWU:

i) Issuance of Registration Certificates

Registration Certificate, Mark sheet and Pass Certificate will be signed jointly by the authorized person of DHWU and Director / In-charge of ICCILLSR.

The ICCILLSR will pay Rs. 2000/- per student per semester to the DHWU as administrative charges. The fees may be enhanced / changed from time to time as per necessity.

In the beginning of the MoU, ICCILLSR is permitted to offer Diploma Course in Journalism & Mass Communication, Media with effect from mutual consent. The duration of the course is 1 year with 2 semester system. Eligibility criteria, admission process and course fees will be determined by the ICCILLSR following Govt. / NCERT /UGC norms.

Other courses may be permitted to open on mutual agreement in future.

For obtaining affiliation or approval, if required, from NCERT, UGC, or any other Govt. bodies to run any particular Course / Courses, ICCILLSR will have to bear the sole responsibility to get that concurrence.
